NASSAU CHAPTER HIGH SCHOOL SCHOLARSHIP

PURPOSE:

To provide Financial Assistance to dependent children and grandchildren of members in good standing of Nassau Chapter or Columbiettes to further their Catholic High School education.

SCHOLARSHIP:

Scholarships are awarded based on the scholastic aptitude of the child and the child's activity within his or her Church and Community. The scholarships are awarded without consideration of financial need. A one-thousand dollar scholarship is awarded incoming freshman and may be renewed yearly provided the recipient's scholarship, attendance, behavior and community service is far above standard. In addition, two one-year scholarship's of five hundred dollars each will be awarded for first and second runner up. Scholarships will be awarded as follows: One scholarship of \$1000.00 payable directly to the school in two payments (usually in September and January) and two one-year scholarship's of \$500.00 each payable directly to the school in September.

REQUIREMENTS:

1. Applicant must be a child, grandchild, or legal ward of a Knight of Columbus, or Columbiette member of Nassau Chapter in good standing, or a Squire or Squirette (should such organizations exist at the time of application) in good standing. Children of deceased members whose demise occurred while in good standing are also eligible.
2. Acceptance in a Catholic High School for the year beginning September 2007. Proof of registration is required.
3. Financial Secretary's verification of member's good standing.
4. Signature of Parent/Guardian is required to certify the accuracy of all answers on the application.

FILING OF SCHOLARSHIPS:

Financial need is not a factor. The Scholarship Application MUST be accompanied by the following four (4) documents:

1. A transcript of the students final marks for grades 6 and 7 and the mid-year grades for grade 8.
2. A letter of recommendation from an educator of the currently attended school specifying the student's scholastic achievements and activities in the school.
3. Proof of registration in a Catholic High School for the academic year beginning September 2007.
4. A essay, written by the student describing a) his or her understanding of the work of the Knights of Columbus and b) the student's activities within his or her Parish and Community.

NOTE: DOCUMENTS SUPPLIED OTHER THAN THOSE SPECIFIED ABOVE WILL **NOT BE** CONSIDERED.
