## Columbus Club Briefs

My Brother Knights and Sister Columbiettes:

I have good news for you! During last month's K of C meeting, April 11th, we finally held the Special Meeting of the Columbus Club. Our March meeting was cancelled because of Winter Storm Stella. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the purchasing of the convent at Holy Spirit Church. The discussion centered on several stipulations and questions submitted to us by the Diocese of Rockville Centre in a "Letter of Intent." With a large number of Brothers in attendance an overwhelming majority of the members voted to go forward with the purchase of the convent. The next step is for Brother Knight Kevin Fitzpatrick to draw up a brief based on our answers and present it to the Diocese for their approval of the sale. Brother Kevin is an attorney, who is volunteering his time and expertise in advising Father Grieco on the sale of the convent. If the Diocese is satisfied and gives its final approval of the sale, our next step would be to do our "due diligence." This means contacting the New Hyde Park Village officials and others to find out what would be required of us to make the convent our Council home. Getting to this point was two years in the making. I would like to thank Father Grieco for his resolve in making sure this project moved along. He is as enthusiastic as we are and he believes we will be able to accomplish many of the goals of the Knights of Columbus in a place we can call home.

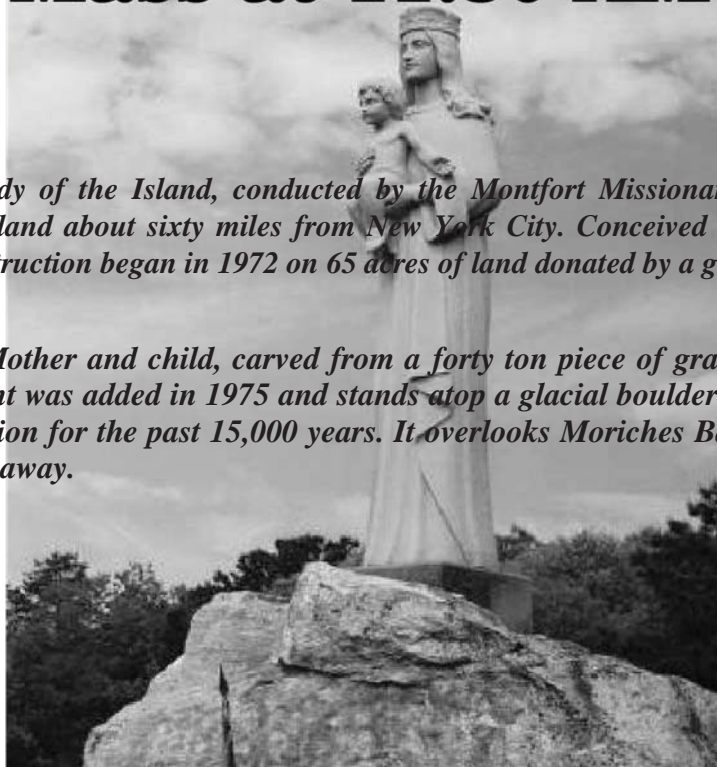

*An 18 foot statue of Mother and child, carved from a forty ton piece of granite at the Rock of Ages Studio in Vermont was added in 1975 and stands atop a glacial boulder of rose quartz that has re-mained in position for the past 15,000 years. It overlooks Moriches Bay and the Atlantic Ocean some five miles away.*

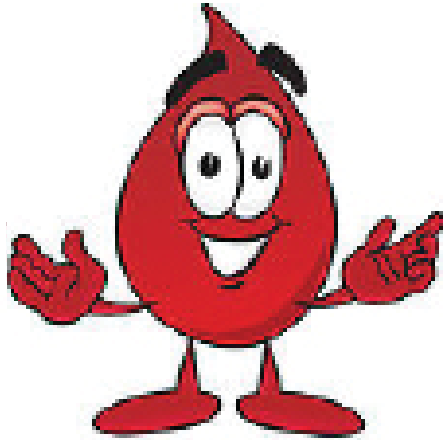
